MOIL FOUNDATION ORGANISED FREE HEALTH CAMP & LIVE STOCK DEVELOPMENT CENTER ON 25th APRIL,2015

Healthy citizens is the main wealth of any nation hence creation of health awareness in the community is undertaken by MOIL Foundation in association with BAIF-MITTRA by organizing Health Camp for treatment of common ailments in nthe areas in the vicinity of MOIL mines under its Community Development Programme, a CSR Initiative of MOIL. One such Free health camp was organized by MOIL foundation and BAIF-MITTRA at Nagardhan near Munsar on 25th April,2015. Shri D.N.Shindey Asst. Vice President of BAIF briefed on the activities of live stock development center. The development center is also equipped with AI Gun, Containers, Semen straw, Pam lets, steakers and extension charts etc..

MOIL Foundation, a Society registered under Society Registration Act, 1860 promoted by **MOIL Limited** (a CSPE under administrative control of Ministry of Steel, Government of India), has entered in an MoU with Maharashtra Institute of Technology Transfer for Rural Areas (**MITTRA**),an Associate Organization of **BAIF** Development Research Foundation for **Community Development Programme.** The main areas of Community Development Programme are agriculture development, livestock Development (poultry development, goat development) women empowerment, quality of life programme etc., which will help in overall development of the area. The project will endeavor to develop resources at the village level for better quality of life. 21 villages have been identified in the vicinity of MOIL mines in the districts of Nagpur, Bhandara of Maharashtra and Balaghat of Madhya Pradesh for the Community Development Progarm. A detailed microplan for development of village resources is prepared.
