Comprehensive guidelines on Complaint Handling Mechanism-Part 9

PIDPI COMPLAINTS

Genesis

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, while hearing the Writ Petition (C) no. 539/2003 relating to the murder of Sh. Satyendra Dubey, directed the Government of India to set up a suitable mechanism for receipt and enactment of complaints from "Whistle-Blowers". Accordingly, Department of Personnel and Training issued Resolution No. 89 dated 21 st April, 2004, commonly known as Public Interest Disclosure and Protection of Informers Resolution, 2004, resolving to set up a mechanism by which a complainant can lodge a complaint in the prescribed manner and also seek protection against his victimization for doing so. (Such complainants, called Whistle Blowers, are entitled to non-disclosures of their identity publically, unless, they themselves do so). The Central Vigilance Commission has been authorized under the PIDPI Resolution, as the Designated Agency to receive complaints from whistle blowers.
